5. Professional Development – Level 1 Google Training continues to be worked on as well as Xello.

6. Technology – Thermal Kiosks have been installed. Chromebooks have been ordered for middle school. The projectors in the preschool and 3rd grade classrooms must be replaced. We have ordered two new 50” monitors.
7. Finance – The CARES ACT Funds Application for DCA has been submitted to Boyle County Public Schools.
8. Public Relations – Opening day press went as well as could be expected.
9. Growth – We must start to think about cleaning out the storage room to make room for another classroom. We are starting to run out of space. It is also necessary to think about utilizing the Common’s Room for the original purpose a preschool room. We can split this room for a preschool classroom and a new Library. We can consider having lunch in the top of the gym. These moves would allow us to open additional classrooms in our current building to make room for increased enrollment.
10. Facilities – (Replace or Repair) Playground Equipment, Floor Tiles in Foyer and Rm. 204, Lockers, we have replaced 2/12 toilets, Upstairs Boys Bathroom - Handicap Handrails, Parking Lot Potholes / Gravel Lot beside the Gym,

Mr. Ward gave the board a tour of the school. We are needing room for the growth we are experiencing. Mr. Ward will continue to look for ways to create space.

Greg Slone made the motion to give Jim permission to use \$15,000 out of the budget to make needed changes for growth. Fred Sizemore 2nd the motion. Motion passed.
